HOUSING EMERGENCY FUND

HEF is a benefit that can assist ODSP and low income individuals and families maintain their current housing.

Low income participants not receiving ODSP are only eligible to apply for rental arrears and utility arrears.

- RENTAL ARREARS: a fund that helps make restitution with rental arrears if served with an N4 eviction notice.
- UTILITY ARREARS: a fund available to those that are facing utility disconnection due to arrears.

TENANT SUPPORT PROGRAM

The Tenant Support Program helps tenants stay housed, prevents possible eviction and supports the tenant at the Landlord Tribunal Board.
